### **Teaching Methodology**

The admission of learners into EDClass is not linear, as is predominantly seen in mainstream education. EDClass may receive as many admissions to the platform in any month not just at the start of the academic year.



In a similar fashion the learners are also not equal in their distribution across year groups and key stages. This outlines just two of the nuances that EDClass needs to consider when looking at shaping our curriculum, and finding a starting point for our learners.
